

MARION COUNTY JAIL



- Onsite, Offsite, and messaging is now available for inmates with NCIC Inmate Communications. Family and friends can set up a visitation account at www.ncic.com. Family and friends **MUST** have a video visitation account to schedule a visit or send a message.
- Your family and friends can begin scheduling as of Monday May 17, 2021.
- You are responsible for making sure you are at the visitation kiosk on time for your visit. **NO ONE** will be calling you to remind you of your visitation. **If you or your visitor fail to login within 5 minutes after the scheduled start time the visit will be automatically cancelled.**
- You can cancel any visit that has been scheduled.
- You also have the responsibility to cancel any visit that you do not want. Your failure to cancel unwanted visits will result in a missed visit. This includes all possible scenarios. If you are removed from your unit for sick call, attorney visit, court or for any other official matter you must make sure that **YOU** cancel any scheduled visit that conflicts.
- If you are moved out of your current unit any scheduled visit will automatically be rescheduled to fit **AVAILABLE** time slots in your new unit unless you have lost your visitation privileges. If no time slots are available, the visit will be cancelled, and your visitor will be notified.
- Although some visits are being conducted remotely the jail can and will monitor activity during the visits. We have this ability both during the visit and by review of archived copies.
- We strongly encourage you to conduct yourself in a manner that will not cause us to terminate or restrict your visitation privileges. It is vital that you advise your visitors that their conduct can also cause you to lose visitation privileges.
